The first amendment is the focus of all our activities and we are advocates for praying in Jesus' name in the public square.

Early every year, we contact State legislators for information on pending legislation that concerns religious freedom. We then pray with insight and take action to support the bills.

We support the National Day of Prayer in our communities by working with local churches who will participate on the first Thursday in May. We advertise in local newspapers to extend an invitation to everyone in the community.



The National Day of Prayer creates unity in our churches and towns. Influential members of the community are selected to pray for each of the seven mountains of influence in society. It is so uplifting to sing patriotic songs and to pray together.

In the months of August and September, we prepare for the September 17th Constitution Day event. It has been held since we began as PRAYUSA in 2007.

In October and November, we make buttons and magnets with sayings that reflect our theme – “Keep Christ in Christmas.” Many local stores display them until after Christmas. The majority are sold at a Crafts Fair. This idea springs from our right to pray in Jesus' name, express our faith, and advocate for the First Amendment.
